PARISH REGISTRATION:

Saint John's Hospice Casserole Program

Country Supper Casserole

2 lbs. ground meat 1 cup chopped onion
1 can sliced Carrots (drained)
1 can green beans (drained) 1 teas. Salt
½ teaspoon pepper 1 lg. can tomato sauce
6 cups Mashed Potatoes (boxed/frozen)
Brown meat and onions. Add salt and pepper
Drain grease. Place browned meat in foil pan.
Spread carrots and green beans over meat.
Pour tomato sauce on top. Top with mashed
potatoes. Place foil lid on top and freeze.

Club Chicken Casserole

1/2 cup margarine 1/2 cup flour
1 12oz can evaporated milk
1 can cream of chicken soup
2 cans chicken broth 1 cup water
1 lb. chopped frozen broccoli
4 cups diced cooked chicken
6 cups cooked brown rice
6 oz. can sliced mushrooms drained
1/3 cup chopped green chili
1/3 cup chopped bell pepper 2 tsp. salt
In a large pan, melt margarine and blend in
flour. Add milk, broth, soup and water and
cook quickly. Stir this constantly until mix-
ture thickens and bubbles. Then add broccoli,
rice, chicken, mushrooms, chili and salt and
stir, mixing well. Pour into a casserole pan
that has been sprayed with pam. Bake uncov-
ered for about 40 minutes in a 350 degree ov-
en Cool and FREEZE!
Lids and Pans are available in our altar server
sacristy. Casseroles are due **Tuesday, June
11.**
