



17th Sunday in Ordinary Time

First Reading: 2 Kings 4: 42-44

Elisha's multiplication of the barley loaves is a direct preview of Jesus' miracle described in this weekend's Gospel passage for Mass.

Second Reading: Ephesians 4: 1-6

Paul stresses the spirit of unity inherent in the new humanity created by Christ. He notes the necessary virtues each member must strive to practice that makes us one in Christ.

Gospel: John 6: 1-15

Jesus takes the initiative and questions Philip for a way out of a difficult problem that has arisen. Jesus' miracle of multiplication solves the food problem but raises new questions to be answered.
