**Confessions** are heard one half-hour before each weekend Mass. Saturday, 3:30pm; Sunday: 7:30am and 10:00am. Penance services are scheduled for Advent and Lenten Seasons.

**Sacrament of Baptism** is held, usually on the last Sunday of each month at noon or at any weekend Mass, with permission. Parents are required to attend Preparation Class prior to baptism of child. Check bulletin for schedule.

**Sacrament of Marriage** Couple contemplating marriage should contact the parish office at least 9-12 months prior to wedding date. Marriage preparation program required.

**Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick** is given as needed. Communion is taken to the sick and shut-ins for First Friday week, usually. If you know someone who is homebound, call the office and request a visit. If a family member is hospitalized, please inform the pastor.

**Parish Membership** is required for Religious Education participation, reception of Baptism, First Penance, First Communion, Confirmation, Matrimony, and issue of sponsor testimonials. All who are over 18 years of age should register as adults even if still living with parents. Please contact the parish office to register. If you are moving or if things change (new telephone number, etc.), please contact the office with that information.

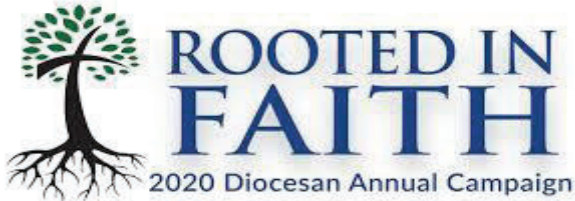
