## Sacraments

### **Baptism:**

**For Infants and Children under age 7:**

The Sacrament of Baptism for Infants and Children is celebrated on Saturdays at 10:00am. First-time Parents are to attend a Sacramental Preparation session prior to the Baptism date. *Contact the office for more information or visit our website [qopchurch.org](http://qopchurch.org) and scroll to Baptism Planning Guide.*

**For Children age 7 through Teens:** Children in this age group are placed with their peers in age appropriate settings to learn about the beauty of the Catholic faith and prepare for their Baptism. *Please contact Linda Carbone in the office.*

### **Marriage:**

Engaged couples desiring to celebrate the Sacrament of Marriage can contact the office to arrange for marriage preparation. Couples desiring to celebrate the Sacrament of Marriage are to meet with a priest or deacon at least six months prior to their intended wedding date. This ought to be done before booking a wedding reception venue.

***We also welcome those couples who are civilly married and desire to receive the Sacrament of Marriage. Contact the Parish Office to arrange for a sacramental convalidation of your marriage.***

### **Anointing of the Sick:**

If you or a family member is hospitalized or in need of the comfort and grace of the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick, please contact the Church Office.

#### **Notice Regarding Reporting Sexual Abuse of a Minor**

It is the policy of the Diocese of Scranton to report any allegation of sexual abuse of a minor to law enforcement. If you are a victim of sexual abuse committed by a priest, deacon, religious or lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton, you are encouraged to immediately report the matter to law enforcement. If any priest, deacon, religious, lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton has cause or reason to suspect that a minor has been subjected to any form of abuse, including child sexual abuse, the matter will be reported to law enforcement. It is also the policy of the Diocese to adhere to all civil and state regulations. In accordance with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania's Child Protective Services Laws, reports of suspected child abuse should also be made immediately by phone to the 24-Hour Child Abuse hotline (ChildLine) at 1-800-932-0313 or electronically at [www.compass.state.pa.us/cwis](http://www.compass.state.pa.us/cwis). To this end, the Diocese is equally committed to adhering to the norms of the Code of Canon Law and to upholding the tenets of the USCCB Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People, which includes supporting victims of sexual abuse in their pursuit of emotional and spiritual well-being. As such, information regarding an allegation of sexual abuse of a minor should also be reported to the Victim Assistance Coordinator Mary Beth Pacuska at 570-862-7551.

Si algún sacerdote, diácono, religioso, empleado laico o voluntario de la Diócesis de Scranton tiene motivos o razones para sospechar que un menor ha sido objeto de cualquier forma de abuso, incluido el abuso sexual infantil, se informará el asunto a las autoridades. También es política de la Diócesis adherirse a todos los reglamentos civiles y estatales. De acuerdo con las Leyes de Servicios de Protección Infantil del estado de Pensilvania, los informes de sospecha de abuso infantil también deben realizarse de inmediato por teléfono a la línea directa de abuso infantil las 24 horas (ChildLine) al 1-800-932-0313 o electrónicamente en [www.compass.state.pa.us/cwis](http://www.compass.state.pa.us/cwis). Con este fin, la Diócesis está igualmente comprometida a adherirse a las normas del Código de Derecho Canónico y a defender los principios del Documento para la Protección de Niños y Jóvenes de la USCCB, que incluye apoyar a las víctimas de abuso sexual en su búsqueda de bienestar emocional y bienestar espiritual. Como tal, la información sobre una acusación de abuso sexual de un menor también debe informarse a la Coordinadora de Asistencia para Víctimas, Mary Beth Pacuska, al 570-862-7551.

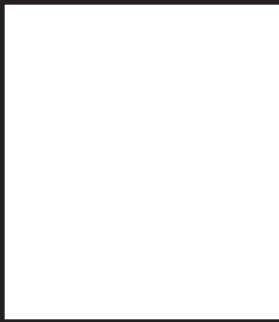
