FAITH FORMATION UPDATES: WHERE WE HAVE BEEN, WHERE WE ARE NOW, AND WHERE WE ARE GOING...

Believe it or not, the catechetical year is winding down. It has been an incredible year! That doesn't mean that our job is over. In fact, it's just beginning. Over the next couple of weeks, you will be receiving a full K-12th Upcoming Fall and Spring Calendar. Until then, here is what is coming up...

**K-6 Faith Formation:** We only have ONE more K-6 Faith Formation Night – **Wednesday, April 17<sup>th</sup>** from 6PM-8PM at DMA. It will be a snack night. A huge thank you to DMA for hosting us this year. I would also like to thank our Catechists who are extremely dedicated to our young disciples, as well as all of the parents who made Faith Formation a priority this year.

**Grade 2nd First Holy Communion Class:** As a reminder, rehearsal for First Holy Communion will be on **Friday, April 19<sup>th</sup>** at 6:30PM in St. Bernadette. Confession will be available at 6PM. First Holy Communion is **Sunday, April 21st** at the 11AM Mass in St. Bernadette. Children are to report to the social hall (Biedenbach) by 10:15AM. Please keep our First Holy Communicants in your prayers as they prepare to receive Jesus for the very first time!

**K-12th Sunday Evening Family Mass:** Our last Sunday evening family Mass is **Sunday, April 28<sup>th</sup>** at 6PM. Some of our K-6th children will be participating in the Mass, so please make every effort to attend. This Mass is open to all K-12th students and their families, and is also open to the entire parish. A light reception will follow in Biedenbach Hall.

**Children's Liturgy of the Word:** Will take a break for the summer. Our last Children's Liturgy for this catechetical year will be on **May 26th**. Thank you to everyone who has helped lead our littles!

**7th-12<sup>th</sup> Youth Ministry:** Our last Youth Ministry night is **Wednesday, April 24th** from 6PM-8PM (Snack Night) in the Lourdes Center. Having Youth Ministry at our parish again has been amazing! Thank you to all of our Catechists who dedicate their time to our young Church, and thank you to all of the many parents who have got on board with us as we charted this ministry off of the ground.

**Grade 8th Confirmation Class:** Our current 8th graders will be in 9th grade by the time that they are Confirmed on **Wednesday, October 2nd** at 7PM in St. Bernadette. They will be meeting once a month over the summer for *Confirmation Class Youth Nights*. This will help them stay informed and connected (and remember everything they have learned about Confirmation over the past year). All of these meetings will be for Confirmation students only and will be on Wednesdays from 6PM-8PM in Lourdes: **May 22nd, June 26th, July 24th, August 28th**. On **Saturday, September 21st**, the Confirmation Class will attend a Retreat at St. Bernadette from 9AM-5PM. The Retreat is for students only. Rehearsal for Confirmation is **Friday, September 29th** at 6:30PM in St. Bernadette. The rehearsal is for students and sponsors. Please keep them in prayer as they prepare to receive the gifts of the Holy Spirit!

**Vacation Bible School:** SAVE THE DATE for **June 17th-21st** from 9AM-12PM. Registration will be available very soon. Current Prek-5 grade students are invited to participate. Current 6th-12th grade students are invited to be youth helpers. We will also need many adult volunteers. There will be a ZOOM MEETING for all interested volunteers on **Monday, April 15<sup>th</sup>** at 6PM. **Camp Virtue:** We will be attending this daily youth camp from **July 8th-12th** at St. Barbara Parish. Upcoming 6th-8th graders can participate and upcoming 9th-12th graders can serve as counselors. Registration information will go home with your children at our next Youth Ministry meeting.

**Incoming Sacramental Classes:** If your child will be entering either 2nd or 8th grade in the 2024-2025 year, please be aware that we will be meeting monthly beginning in September to prepare your child for either Reconciliation/Communion (2nd) or Confirmation (Classes begin in grade 8. Children receive Confirmation in the Fall of their 9th grade year). Sacramental Preparation is required regardless of which school your child attends. These are parent/child meetings. A full schedule will be available in the upcoming weeks.






