FIFTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

APRIL 28, 2024

FROM OUR PRIESTS' DESKS:

Dear brothers and sisters of Sacred Heart,

When Jesus in the Gospel looked at a vineyard, as he does in today's Gospel reading, he didn't see dollar signs, nor did he especially think about how good the grapes or the wine might taste. Rather, he thought about a profound and mysterious relationship that was demonstrated by the vines and the branches of the grape plant. From almost the beginning of the Old Testament grapes are repeatedly referred to as reflecting the plan of God concerning the welfare of his people; so Jesus was following a long and venerable Jewish tradition.

In nature, as we know, things more or less happen in a mechanical and predictable way: the annual cycle of growth in the spring, maturity in summer, decline in the fall, and dormancy in the winter, repeats itself over and over; only the rate of growth changes, depending on temperature and rainfall and sunshine. Growth in the human person, especially spiritual growth, depends on different conditions, the most important of which are always the grace of God, and our own free decision to accept that grace: the frequency and sincerity of our prayer; the intensity of our desire to know, love, and serve God; the generosity of our commitment to others and to their welfare, to promoting the common good rather than simply our own personal good. While God's grace always remains constant because his love for us is unchanging, our own response changes from day to day and sometimes from hour to hour because we are free to say yes or no to God's plan for us. May we remain always united to Him who is the true vine, and may his life flow through us, making our lives fruitful, and through us bringing this fruitfulness to others as well, to all those who are hungry and thirsty for the life and the love of God.


