THE COMMUNION OF SAINTS

On this Sunday, November 1st, the Church celebrates a wonderful feast - the Feast of All the Saints. The word "saint" means holy. It is applied first of all to God - Who alone is the Holy One. But all those who are baptized into Jesus are made *holy* by being washed clean of sin by His Blood.

The Church of Jesus - all those who belong to Him - is not limited by death. So, the many Christians who have gone before us and are now in heaven are called "**the Saints**", all of those who, by the grace of Jesus, have reached the perfection of holiness in heaven are part of the Church.

The Virgin Mary, the Mother of Jesus, is called the **Queen of Saints**. In fact, Pope Pius XII chose November 1st as the day for the definition of the Dogma of the Assumption in 1950. Of all those who share in the **victory of Jesus**, she is the highest, because no evil touched her.

There are many **canonized Saints** - those whose perfection of life in Jesus has been officially recognized by the Church and who we know are in



heaven. And there are thousands of **uncanonized Saints** - we do not know them, but in the past 2,000 years, many have gone before us in Christ.

The Saints in heaven are not dead or sleeping - they are fully alive in the power of the Spirit of Jesus. They continue to pray and act in Jesus' Spirit for us, doing good on earth by their prayers.

It is not true that Catholics *worship Saints*: we worship God alone; we adore Jesus, the Lord of the whole universe. But we do **venerate the Saints: hold them in high honor**. In this day and age, when so many people of evil and corruption have become "models" for our youth, the Church of Jesus presents before the world her **Saints**: true models of life in Christ. If you want to imitate anyone, imitate Jesus, His Mother and His Saints.

It is also true that we *pray to* Saints. "Pray to" does not mean "adore". We talk to them as to brothers and sisters in Christ, and ask them to join with us in our fight to establish the Kingdom of Jesus on earth. "In every age, O Lord, you have made people holy!"

LA COMMUNION DES SAINTS

Ce dimanche, l'Église célèbre une grande fête - la Toussaint. La parole "saint" s'applique en premier lieu à Dieu - Lui seul est **le Saint**. Mais tous ceux qui sont baptisés en Jésus sont devenus *saints* en étant lavés du péché par Son Sang.

L'Église de Jésus - tous ceux qui Lui appartiennent - n'est pas limitée par la mort. Ainsi, il y a beaucoup de Chrétiens qui nous ont précédés qui se trouvent aux cieux. On les appelle "**les Saints**". Tous ceux qui, par la grâce de Jésus, sont arrivés à la perfection de la sainteté dans les cieux sont membres de l'Église.

On appelle la Vierge Marie, la Mère de Jésus, la **Reine des Saints**. En effet, Pape Pie XII a choisi le 1^{er} novembre comme le jour pour la définition du dogme de l'Assomption en 1950. De tous ceux qui partagent de la **victoire de Jésus**, elle est la plus haute, car aucun mal ne l'a touchée.

Il y a beaucoup de **Saints canonisés** - ceux dont la perfection de vie en Jésus a été reconnue officiellement par l'Église et nous savons qu'ils sont déjà aux cieux. Mais il y a aussi des milles de **Saints non-canonisés** - nous ne les connaissons pas,

mais dans les derniers 2,000 ans beaucoup nous ont précédés dans le Christ.

Les Saints des cieux ne sont pas morts et ils ne dorment pas - il sont pleinement vivants dans la puissance de l'Esprit de Jésus. Ils continuent à prier et à agir dans l'Esprit de Jésus pour nous, en faisant le bien par leurs prières.

Les Catholiques *n'adorent pas les Saints*: nous n'adorons que Dieu; nous rendons culte à Jésus, le Seigneur de l'univers entier. Mais nous **vénérons les Saints: en les mettant en haut honneur**. Aujourd'hui, quand il y a tant de gens de méchanceté et corruption qui sont devenus "modèles" pour nos jeunes, l'Église de Jésus présente au monde ses **Saints**: vrais modèles de la vie en Christ. Si vous cherchez quelqu'un à imiter, imitez Jésus, Sa

Mère et Ses Saints.

C'est aussi vrai que nous *prions aux Saints*. "Prier aux" ne veut pas dire "adorer". Nous les parlons comme l'on parle à ses frères et sœurs dans le Christ, et les invitons à prier dans notre bataille d'établir le Royaume de Jésus sur la terre. "Dans tous les âges, ô Seigneur, Tu as fait des hommes saints!"

Hoy día, cuando tantas personas de mala vida y corrupción han llegado a ser "modelos" para nuestra juventud la Iglesia de Jesús presenta al mundo sus **Santos**: verdaderos modelos de vida en Cristo. Si quieres imitar a alguien, imita a Jesús, a Su Madre y a Sus Santos.

Además es verdad que *les oramos a los Santos*. "Orarles" no quiere decir "adorar". Les hablamos como a hermanos en Cristo, y les pedimos que se junten con nosotros en nuestra lucha para establecer el Reino de Jesús en la tierra.
