Dear Friends,

Today is known as *Laetare* Sunday. “Laetare” is the Latin for “rejoice”. It is known as this because it is the first word of the Entrance Antiphon for today’s Mass: *Rejoice, Jerusalem, and all who love her. Be joyful, all who were in mourning; exult and be satisfied at her consoling breast.* We are called to rejoice because we are getting closer and closer to the joy of the Resurrection at Easter. Can you believe it? Ash Wednesday was nearly a month ago!

On this Fourth Sunday of Lent I want to encourage us to stay the course as we draw near to Easter. If we have been faithful to our Lenten resolutions we are no doubt feeling it thus far. Let us not lose our momentum. The Lord has more work to do in us, let us maintain those open and receptive hearts. As I said on Ash Wednesday, Lent is about healing; God healing us from sin and the effects thereof. It is in this vein that I want to focus my reflection over the next two weeks. In particular, to look at the sacraments of Reconciliation and Anointing of the Sick and provide a brief catechesis on these two sacraments of healing, as the catechism calls them. We will look first at the Sacrament of the Sick this week and next week as well.

What is the sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick?

As one of the seven Sacraments, the Anointing of the Sick is a tangible sign that bestows sanctifying grace. Sacraments are efficacious. That means they *do* what they signify. In baptism, for example, the sign of water, which in normal usage is used for washing — amongst other things — carries out invisibly what it does visibly, that is, it washes the soul clean from sin; original sin if one is an infant and both original and actual sin if one receives baptism after the age of reason.

With regard to the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick, the visible sign of oil, which people used from ancient times as something to bring healing and strength works invisibly the same effects on the soul.

Is the Anointing of the Sick found in the Bible?

Yes! Like all the Sacraments, the Anointing of the Sick was established by the Lord. In Matthew 10:8, Jesus told his disciples to “heal the sick”. In Mark 6:12—13, the gospel tells us “and they [the disciples] cast out many demons, and anointed with oil many that were sick and healed them.” The Lord Jesus communicated His divine power to His disciples. The main passage that proves this particular Sacrament is found in the Bible is in the Letter of James 5:14—15: “Is anyone sick among you? Let him bring in the priests of the Church and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord. And the prayer of faith will save the sick person and the Lord will raise him up and if he be in sins, they shall be forgiven.”

Will this Sacrament heal me of my sickness?

Maybe, if it is conducive to your eternal salvation. Christ instituted this Sacrament to give spiritual aid and strength and to perfect spiritual health, including, if need be, the remission of sins. It may also restore bodily health to Christians who are seriously ill, if it helps promote their eternal salvation.

Is this Sacrament only for the dying?

No. The Anointing of the Sick is for those of advanced age as well as those about to undergo serious surgery or experiencing serious illness.

Is this Sacrament known by any other names?

Yes. This Sacrament is also called the “Sacrament of the Sick” and, if someone is in the process of dying, it is also called “Extreme Unction”.




