Thursday, March 21st at 7PM in the Church

Tenebrae is a prolonged meditation on Christ's suffering. Readings trace the story of Christ's passion, powerful music enriches the prayer, and the power of silence and darkness suggests the drama of this momentous day. As candles are extinguished, we ponder the depth of Christ's suffering and death; we remember the cataclysmic nature of his sacrifice; and through the return of the small but persistent flame of the Christ candle at the conclusion of the service, we anticipate the joy of ultimate victory.

This is a prayerful, powerful way to spend an evening in preparation for Palm Sunday (where the Passion of our Lord is Proclaimed), Holy Week, and the great celebration of Easter. While everyone is encouraged to attend, please consider that this program has long periods of silence when deciding whether or not to bring small children.



Prayer for Our Troops O God of mercy, we ask You to protect in a special way those who are fighting for us and for the country we love. Bless them and take care of them. Give them strength. Give them comfort. Touch them with Your gentle hand and let them know that You are near them. Hasten the day, dear Lord, when we may all enjoy the blessings of peace. Amen.
