Camp Lots-of-Fun is Family Promise's day camp for children ages 5-12 in a shelter and support programs, as well as kids experiencing housing instability that are referred to them from other organizations in Bergen County. For the families, camp meets a critical need by filling the gap in daycare when most summer programs end and school has yet to begin. But for the children, it means so much more.

The camp will be taking place at St. Catharine's beginning Monday, Aug. 19 to Friday, Aug. 30 in the Holmes Building. The children in the program will be served breakfast and lunch each day, as well as lunches for the volunteer counselors.

St. Catharine parish is signed up for 4, possibly 5 lunches and 1 or 2 breakfasts, as well as providing all the paper goods needed for the two weeks. If we have enough funds an additional lunch and/or breakfast will also be provided or other need that the camp needs covered.
