FROM THE PASTOR

This is the final Sunday in Ordinary Time for the Liturgical Year of 2018. This Sunday’s Gospel reminds us about the End Times and the Second Coming of the Lord.

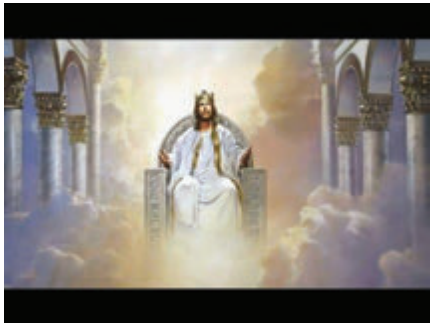


In her Notebooks, St. Sister Faustina wrote about the End Days as the Lord spoke to her about them. Even Our Blessed Mother, who also appeared to Sister Faustina, spoke to her about this belief of our faith. Many folks wonder about this, but

our Faith affirms that “HE WILL COME AGAIN IN GLORY TO JUDGE THE LIVING and THE DEAD!” And following are the words of Our Lord and His Blessed Mother about this belief of our Faith:

“Before I come as the Just Judge, I come as the King of Mercy. Before the day of Justice arrives, there will be given to people a sign in the heavens of this sort: All light in the heavens will be extinguished, and there will be great darkness over the earth. Then the sign of the cross will appear in the sky, and from the openings where the Hands and Feet of the Savior were nailed will come forth great lights which will light up the earth for a period of time. This will take place shortly before the Last Day.” (from the words of Jesus to Sister Faustina, paragraph # 83)

“I gave the Savior to the world; as for you, you have to speak to the world about His great mercy and prepare the world for the Second Coming of Him who will come, not as a



merciful Savior but as a Just Judge. Oh, how terrible is that day! Determined is the Day of Justice, the Day of Wrath! The angels tremble before it! Speak to souls about this great mercy while it is still time for mercy. If you keep

silent now, you will be answering for a great number of souls on that terrible day! Fear nothing! Be faithful to the end. I sympathize with you.” (from the words of Blessed Mary to Sister Faustina, paragraph #635)

We live in the shadow of this coming Day! But what matters most is that we live in a state of Grace, be faithful to Christ, and always be ready to stand before Him!



I pray that all of you enjoy a Blessed Thanksgiving Day. Please remember to pause and give thanks to Him who has bestowed so many blessings upon each of us, upon our parish, upon our community and upon our country!
